Aging Focused Community Impact

The Junior League of Greensboro (JLG) began a more focused approach for community impact in June 2013 by partnering with Cone Elementary, a title I elementary school located in northeast Greensboro, a school within the Guilford County School System. After partnering with Cone Elementary for three school years, The Junior League of Greensboro has voted on a new impact area: Aging, which began in the 2017-2018 League year. Proposals are currently being accepted for community programs that focus on issues surrounding aging within Guilford County. All community programs selected must benefit the aging population in some way.

Organization Requirements

1. To be eligible for League funding, your organization must:
 - a) Serve the Greensboro Community
 - b) Have tax exempt status (for no less than 2 years)

2. Organizations receiving League funding agree to:
 - a) Document expenses for grant funding and volunteer time in the form of two bi-annual reports, submitted to the Junior League of Greensboro in December and April
 - b) Provide our volunteers with meaningful volunteer opportunities
 - c) Participate in an evaluation of outcomes

Proposal Requirements

1. All proposals must support our mission (i.e. *to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving the community through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers/purpose is exclusively educational and charitable*).
2. You must complete the **Aging Impact Proposal Form** and submit it along with all required attachments by **October 31, 2018**. The completed form should be typed in 12 font, no longer than six pages. Do not send attachments that have not been requested. 3. JLG does not consider funding for: individual's projects, religious projects, government entities, fundraising or capital campaigns, and political activities.
4. Additionally, JLG will not fund the following budget line items:
 - a. travel expenses
 - b. salaries
 - c. insurance
 - d. office rent or office equipment usage
 - e. tuition/scholarships
5. The following attachments are required:
 - a) Agency Reviewed Financials
 - b) Current Agency Budget
 - c) 501(c)(3) Letter of Determination
 - d) Board of Directors List
 - e) Line-item budget for proposed project
